Notice is hereby given pursuant to Section 14(2) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act, 1984, that the Oxfordshire County Council

**TEMPORARILY PROHIBITS THE USE OF THE HIGHWAY
BY ALL MOTOR VEHICLES**

LOCATION: Pishill with Stonor, Un-named road Russells Water

REASON: To facilitate Open Reach works

DURATION: Starting on 1 October 2019
The anticipated completion date is 3 October 2019 (date included)
(Traffic Regulation Notices cover a maximum of 5 consecutive days.)

ACCESS: Limited access will be maintained for emergency service vehicles and for frontages within the closed section of road, subject to the progress of the works

SUGGESTED ALTERNATIVE ROUTE: ROAD RUNNING THROUGH RUSSELLS WATER - RED LANE - SECTION OF B480 KNOWN AS PATEMORE LANE - SECTION OF B480 RUNNING THROUGH PISHIL - ROAD RUNNING THROUGH STONOR - ROAD KNOWN AS PARK LANE RUNNING WEST FROM RENVYLE - ROAD RUNNING THROUGH MAIDENSGROVE - ROAD FROM UPPER MAIDENSGROVE SKIRTING RUSSELLS WATER COMMON – vice versa.
